

- 10. Commit to Continuous Improvement**

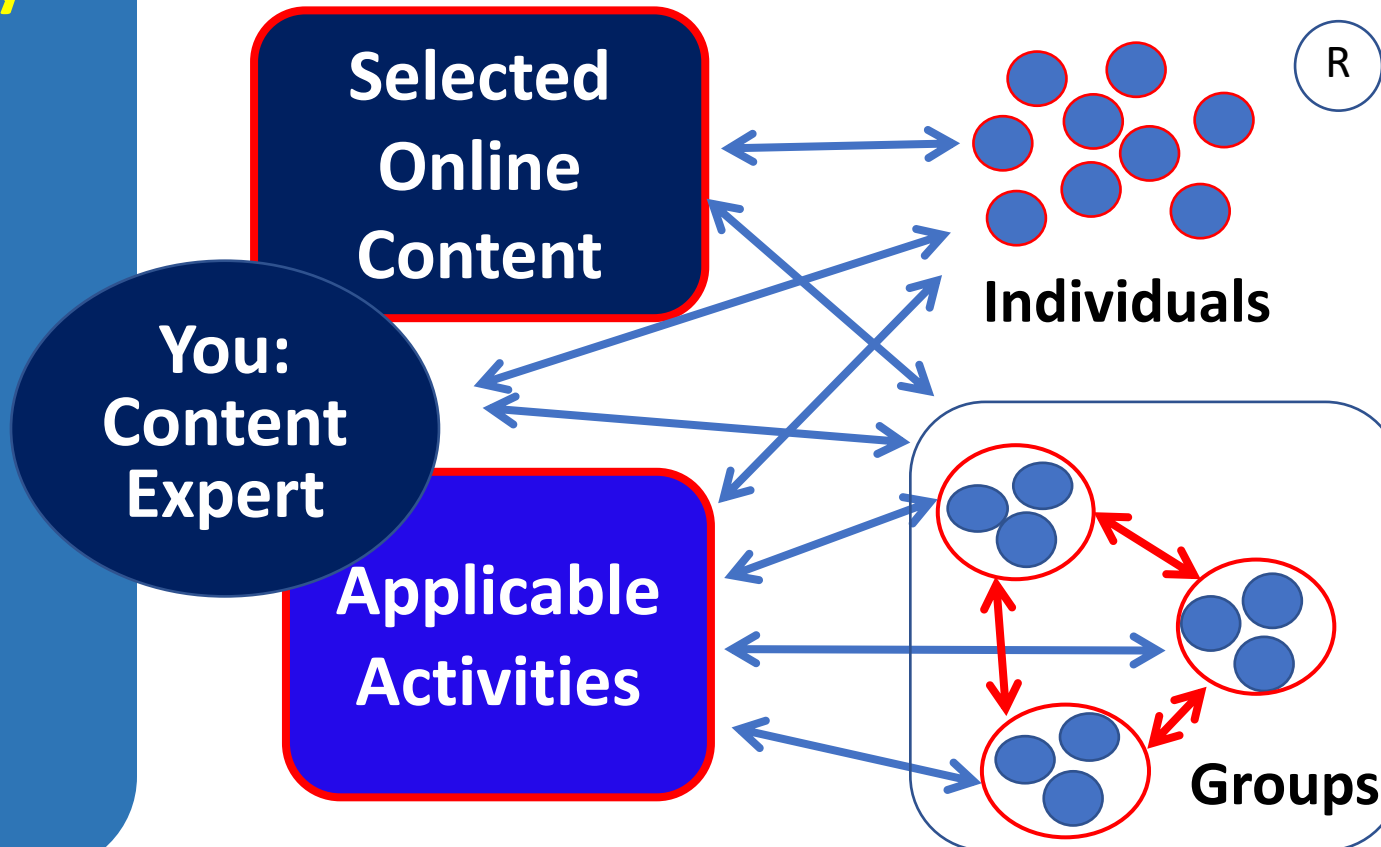
